#### The Shotmaker Electronic Target System will be used

- 1. RANGE LOCATION: The Winnequah Gun club is approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 West to Exit 115; turn right onto County Road CS (0.2 miles); turn left at County Road J (1.1 miles); turn right at County Road J at the T in the road (3.3 miles). Look for Winnequah Gun Club sign and Indoor Range on your left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. The club address is: W10219 Larson Dr., Lodi WI 53555. More information is on the club web site (<a href="www.winnequahgunclub.org">www.winnequahgunclub.org</a>). Camping is permitted; the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Friday August 1,2025.
- 2. FACILITIES: A camping area is available during the matches, for competitors only (fees are \$10.00 per day). Contact Karin Liebetrau at <a href="mailto:ekl@mwt.net">ekl@mwt.net</a> to reserve a camping spot. Camping is for electricity only, no water; there is room for putting up a tent if necessary.
- 3. RULES: Current NRA F-Class Rules shall apply.
- 4. ELIGIBILITY: Open to anyone.
- 5. ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED: All entries must be paid in advance.
- 6. INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry in individual events on enclosed Registration & Entry form (include NRA Membership ID number). Entries MUST be accompanied by check or money order. Make payable to Winnequah Gun Club (or WGC). Mail to Karin Liebetrau, 10890 Cornell Dr., Viola WI 54664, phone 608-345-7989, Email: ekl@mwt.net. Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, providing cancellation is made prior to 4:00 pm, Monday, August 1.
- 7. ENTRIES CLOSE: 4:00 PM Monday, July 21,2025. Entries after this time are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only. An additional \$20.00 will be charged for late entries. No relays will be added after July 21, 2025.
- 8: ENTRY LIMITS: 240 Individual entries.

9. FEES: Mid-Range - Individual entries all indiv matches: \$200.00

- Both Team Matches: (pay at range) \$120.00 Long Rang - Individual entries all indiv matches: \$200.00

- Both Team Matches: (pay at range) \$120.00

LATE ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 in addition to appropriate match fee.

CHALLENGE FEE: \$3.00 The challenge fee must be paid at the time the challenge is requested.

- 10. TARGETS: 600 yds MR-1FC; 1000 yds LRFC
- 11. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): Approved NRA empty chamber indicators are required to be used at all times except during the preparation period time and firing. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the Stat Office for \$2.00 each.
- 12. SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at the Stat Ofice starting at approximately 6:30 am Saturday August 2. Any competitor who fails to obtain their squadding ticket by 7:30 am will only be squadded to fill vacancies.
- 13. SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform their scoring duties may be disqualified. Competitors are expected to bring a scope or binoculars to verify the shots going into the target. The club has a limited supply of tablets please bring your own tablet.
- 14. CLASSIFICATION: NRA F-Class classifications will be used. Those competitors unclassified or without proof of a lower classification, will be required to compete in the Master class. Please indicate classification on the registration and entry form.
- 15. DIVISION BY RIFLE: F-Open and F-TR.
- 16. AWARDS: Medals, trophies and cash awards will be given. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place, etc. awards will be given based on one award for each 10 (10) competitors. Daily awards will be given out at the end of each day. Mid-Range awards will be given to Grand Aggregate Champions for scores fired in Matches 4, 8 and 12, and Long Range awards will be given for scores fired in Matches 4, 8 and 14. Awards must be picked up at range or banquet. If not picked up award will be donated to junior club. Awards will not be mailed.

SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: In the grand aggregate a High Junior, High Woman, High Senior, and High Grand Senior award will be given if there are 3 or more entries.

17. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends ½ hour after the posting of the match results.
